Dehydration and Heat Stress

- Dehydration and Heat stress have extreme damages to broiler production due to big physiological changes in birds.
- When dehydration happens, waste substances are condensed in the blood and then become toxic to birds.
- Electrolyte imbalance will result in dehydration and make heat stress more serious.

Definition of Heat Stress

- Ambient temperature: more than 26 degree Celsius.
- Relative moisture : more than 75%.

Heat Stress Impact

- Destroy the balance of electrolyte.
- Increase the remove of CO₂.
- Dehydration.

- Decrease Feed efficiency .
- Increase mortality.

How Poultry Respond to Heat Stress

- Sit and rest around wall or water drinker.
- Spread wings to increase heat removal and reduce feed intake.
- Blood flows from organs to skin to accelerate heat remove.
- Increase respiration rate, increase energy consumption and reduce feed efficiency.

Electrolyte Functions

- Osmotic pressure regulation & maintenance of water balance.
- Nerve impulse conduction.
- Muscle contraction.
- Acid-base balance.
- Enzymatic reactions A component of enzymes or activate enzymes.

Main Electrolytes


- 1) Sodium The major cation in the extracellular fluids.
- 2) Chlorine The major anion in body fluids.
- 3) Potassium Serves as the major intracellular cation.
- All three are extremely important for the electrolyte balance.
- Environmental temperature is a crucial factor in the growth performance of poultry.
- In a high temperature there is a decrease in feed intake and in body gain, and additions
 of certain nutrients to feed or drinking water can reduce these effects.
- Electrolyte balance in feed has a significant influence on body weight gain and feed intake.
- Sodium bicarbonate is a nutrient with the ability to improve the acid-base balance and the electrolyte balance in blood in high environmental temperature.



Absorption mechanism of MoreGain Electrolytes(active transport system)
